Loose items (floormats, garage openers, I-PASS, etc.) must be removed from the car. All vehicles will require a number, visible on both sides. Student vehicles must have a passenger seat with comparable safety equipment for instructor. No corded tires Brake fluid should be recently flushed (annually or better) Sufficient brake pad material, 50% or more recommended Check lug nut torques and tire pressures All brake lights must be functional Check all fluid levels (brake, coolant, oil) No visible fluid leaks Hoses and belts should be in good condition Steering should be tight, with no play No bare or exposed wires No frame rust Battery securely mounted
